



## **Burnham Week 2021**

### **Change to Sailing Instructions No 5**

#### **Change to Si 17.4**

The Post-Race Penalty is changed, with the new text underscored, so as to read:  
A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 of the Racing Rules of Sailing or rule 31 may, after finishing the race concerned and before the start of any related protest hearing, notify the race committee that it accepts a Post-Race Penalty - a one-place penalty for a race with 10 or fewer boats that came to the starting area and a two-place penalty for a race with 11 or more boats that came to the starting area, except that the boat shall not be scored worse than the number of boats that came to the starting area. However, if the boat caused injury or serious damage or, despite taking a penalty, gained a significant advantage in the the race or series by its breach, its penalty shall be to retire. The scores of other boats shall not be changed; therefore two boats may receive the same score.
