SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (S.I.s)

The notation '[N.P.]' in a rule of the sailing instructions (S.I.s) means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation '[D.P.]' in a rule in the S.I. means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and I.R.C. Rules. R.R.S. A5.1 and A5.2 is changed as follows A boat that does not start within ten minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes R.R.S. A5.1 and A5.2.

For the class (All Classes), RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

- 1.2 Rule 40.1 Shall apply all times whilst afloat for dinghy sailors.
- 1.3 [NP] Boats are required to display, from their backstay (or starboard shroud if no backstay), their Burnham Week flag whilst racing

2 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at www.Burnhamweek.com/noticeboard
- 3.2 The race office is located at the Royal Burnham Yacht Club, opening Friday 25th 2pm till 5pm. Saturday 26th at 09.30 till 12.00 Sunday and the rest of the week from 10.00- 12.00
The office will be open from 16h – to 18h for protest forms.
- 3.3 In addition, Burnham Week may use WhatsApp to notify competitors information. no errors, omissions, or delay in doing so, nor the failure by a boat to receive or hear such VHF transmissions or WhatsApp messaging, will be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 60.1 (b) and 62.1 (a).

4 CODE OF CONDUCT

- 4.1 [D.P.] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.
- 4.2 [D.P.] Competitors and support persons shall place advertising provided by the organising authority with care, and seamanship, in accordance with any instructions for its use and without interfering with its functionality.
- 4.3 Boats shall ensure that their sail numbers are in a suitable contrast to the sail to be easily readable by the Race Committee.
- 4.4 An entered boat making toward the racing area, racing, or leaving the racing area shall not touch a moored vessel a mooring buoy to which.
(A) a vessel is moored or cause another boat to do so.
(B) When a boat while racing touches a moored vessel:(a) her penalty is to retire unless she protests another boat and is exonerated under **rule/ RRS 64.1(a)**.
(C) the owner/person in charge shall report the collision to the Race Officer and the Crouch Harbour Authority, telephone number 01621 783 602
email: info@crouchharbour.org.uk This reporting obligation is in addition to and not in substitution of the reporting obligation contained in CHA Bye law 24.

8 RACING AREA

8.1 The racing area is Rivers Crouch and Roach

9 COURSES

9.1 Courses to be sailed will be selected from race marks described in Si appendix A and the Roach and Crouch navigation marks.

9.2 Courses will be displayed on the Burnham week website only.

9.3 Race signals relevant to the B.S.C. line will be displayed on the balcony of the B.S.C.

9.4 Multihull afternoon races will be broadcast from the start/finish committee boat.

9.5 Boats racing shall use all reasonable endeavours to avoid contact with navigation buoys, whether they are marks of the course or not. In the case of contact, the circumstances of the incident and including details of any damage shall be reported to the race committee within the protest time limit. If the navigation buoy has been damaged the race committee may protest the boat. If a boat is forced by the actions of another boat to collide with a navigation buoy her only remedy is to protest

9.6 The race committee may set courses that do not permit boats to sail rhumb line courses between marks. This shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

10 MARKS

10.1 River racing marks and navigational buoys. Multi Hull fleet will have an additional orange pillar buoy laid in the river Roach as their turning mark

11 OBSTRUCTIONS

11.1 The following object (s, area(s) are designated as an obstruction(s):

Barges East of Rice and Coles moorings.

There are marker posts on the South Bank of the River Crouch denoting the breaches to the wall and entrances to the wetlands. There are underwater hazards and obstructions on the foreshore/riverbanks around the breaches.

11.2 On the West bank of the River Roach, there are underwater hazards in the entrances to the wetlands.

12 THE START

12.1 Races will be started using R.R.S. 26 with the warning signal made 5 minutes before the starting signal.

12.2 **Start lines** (a) The Pile House (P.H.) start lines will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a B.W.L. Committee vessel and an orange buoy, south of the Committee vessel, East of Fairway No. 3.

(b) The Burnham Sailing Club (B.S.C.) line is between a triangle on the B.S.C. Race Box and a triangle on the South shore.

- 12.3 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall keep clear of boats whose preparatory signal has been made. An infringement of this rule may not be protested by another boat but may result in a time penalty of 3% being given, without a hearing, by the Race Committee. Subsequent infringements during the Regatta may result in the boat being disqualified by the Race Committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 60.1 and 63.1.
- 12.4 If any part of a boat's hull is on the course side of the starting line at her starting signal and is identified, the race committee will attempt to hail her sail number. Failure to hail her number, failure of her to hear such a hail, or the order in which boats are hailed will not be grounds for a redress for request. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- 12.5 If a general recall is signalled after the start signal for one class which was also the warning signal for the next class, the display of flag First Substitute will simultaneously signal the general recall of the first class and the postponement of the start sequence for the second class. Flag AP will not be displayed in addition. First Substitute will be removed one minute before the next warning signal for the recalled class, whose start signal will also be the warning signal for the second class. The Race Committee will endeavour to update the remaining fleets via courtesy broadcasts advising revised timings. This changes RRS Race Signals.
- 13 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE n/a
- 14 THE FINISH
- 14.1 The Finishing lines
- (a) The Pile House (P.H.) finish line will be between a staff displaying a Blue flag on a B.W. Committee vessel and an orange buoy, north of the Committee vessel, East of Fairway No. 3.
- (b) The Burnham Sailing Club (B.S.C.) finish line is between a triangle on the B.S.C. Race Box and a triangle on the South shore.
- (c) Multihull, Committee boat on station at the end of the multi-course, a line between a staff displaying a blue flag and the adjacent mark.
- (d) The Royal Corinthian Yacht Club line is between a triangle on the R.C.Y.C. Race Box and a triangle on the south shore
- 14.2 If flag H is displayed from a Burnham Week committee vessel at a rounding mark or gate, the course changes. Pass the mark on the correct side from the direction of the previous mark and sail to the designated finish line.
- 14.3 If flag S is displayed from a Burnham Week committee vessel (displays flag S with two sounds), the finishing line shall be at a rounding mark, between the mark and the staff displaying flag S. The shortened course shall be signalled before the first boat crosses the finishing line.

15 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 15.1 For the class (All Classes), RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 15.2 The notation [DP] in a rule in Sailing Instructions means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification.

16 TIME LIMITS

- 16.1 The Mark 1 Time Limit, Race Time Limit (see R.R.S. 35), and the Finishing Window are shown below.

- 16.2 If no boat has passed the first mark within the Mark 1 Time Limit, the race will be abandoned.
- 16.3 The Finishing Window is the time for boats to finish after the first boat sails the course and finishes. Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window and not subsequently retiring, penalised or given redress will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing. A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place, one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the Finishing Window. This changes R.R.S. 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10.
- 16.4 Failure to meet the Race Target Time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

17 HEARING REQUESTS

- 17.1 For Burnham Week 2023, the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat finishes the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later. The time will be posted on the official notice board.
- 17.2 Hearing request forms are available from the race office at Royal Burnham Yacht Club.
- 17.3 Notices will be posted no later than 60 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named witnesses. Hearings will be

- held in the clubs' protest room, location to be confirmed on notices.
- 17.4 The Post-Race Penalty, Advisory Meeting, and RYA Arbitration procedures of the RYA Rules Disputes procedures shall apply. The outcome of an RYA Arbitration can be referred to a protest committee, but an arbitration cannot be reopened or appealed. See the Official online Notice Board for details.
- 17.5 A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 of the Racing Rules of Sailing or rule 31 may, after finishing the race concerned and before the start of any related protest hearing, notify the race committee that it accepts a Post-Race Penalty - a one-place penalty for a race with 10 or fewer boats that came to the starting area and a two-place penalty for a race with 11 or more boats that came to the starting area, except that the boat shall not be scored worse than the number of boats that came to the starting area. However, if the boat caused injury or severe damage or, despite taking a penalty, gained a significant advantage in the race or series by its breach, its penalty shall be to retire. The scores of other boats shall not be changed; therefore, two boats may receive the same score.

18 SCORING

- 18.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low point system.
- 18.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 18.3 A boat's series score is the total of her race scores.
- 18.4 When Four races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores, excluding her one worst score.
- 18.5 When Seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores, excluding her two worst scores.
- 18.6 Rule A5.3 applies.
- 18.7 For Burnham Week 2023
R.B.O.D. Fleet week's points eight days.
R.B.O.D. WILSON SANDERSON MEMORIAL CUP Mid-week points (Tuesday – Friday) no discards
R.C.O.D. weeks points series is seven days.
Dragon weeks points series is seven days.

(seven days Saturday to Friday)

19 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 19.1 [DP] Personal flotation devices, when required to be worn, shall be clearly visible to other boats and the race committee.
- 19.2 [D.P.] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable

- opportunity by Radio to the Committee vessel on CH72. By SMS to 03300 969819
- 19.3 Under rule 42.3 (h), Boats in classes 1, 2, 5, and 6 may, after running aground, use their engines to get clear. If they do so, they shall, after getting clear and having stopped their engine and before continuing with the race, take a Two Turns Penalty as per rule 44.2. Such action shall be reported to the Race Officer within the protest time limit.
- 20 REPLACEMENTS OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT
- 20.1 No requirements for crew replacement.
- 21 EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS
- 21.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected for compliance with the class rules, notice of race and sailing instructions.
- 22 Boats shall ensure that their sail numbers are in a suitable contrast to the sail to be easily readable by the Race Committee.
- 23 OFFICIAL VESSELS
- 23.1 Official vessels such as: Committee boats Ribs, and official support boats shall fly Burnham Week flags.
- 24 [D.P.] SUPPORT TEAMS
- 24.1 Support teams, including all support persons and support person vessels, shall comply with the support team regulations.
- 24.2 Team leaders, coaches and other support persons shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first start until all boats have finished or retired or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- 24.3 Support person vessels shall be identified with "Support."
- 25 TRASH DISPOSAL
- 25.1 Trash to be brought back home and disposed into land bins.
- 26 TRACKING
- 26.1 [DP]Classes one two five and six. For safety and race management purposes, these boats while racing shall register, carry and use a BWL suggested tracking device [Boat Beacon] which shall be one of the following:
- a. An AIS transponder. Competitors shall use their best endeavours to ensure that the device is switched on and transmitting at least once every 5 minutes;
 - b. A compatible mobile device running the App. Competitors shall use their best endeavours to ensure that their boat has one or more such devices onboard and operating (multiple devices are encouraged to ensure compliance with this SI).
- 26.2 Protests for infringement of SI 26.1 may be brought only by the Race Committee. This changes RRS 60 and 63

30 RISK STATEMENT

30.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.**

31 INSURANCE

31.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum of 3 million sterling per incident or the equivalent.
